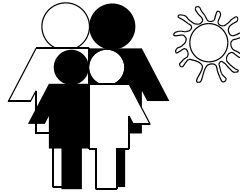

1 = Almost Never

CARD 8

- 1 = Psychiatric Hospital/Psychiatric Unit in a Medical Hospital
- 2 = Detox Unit or Inpatient Drug or Alcohol Unit
- 3 = Hospital Medical Inpatient Unit
- 4 = Residential Treatment Center or Group Home
- 5 = Day Treatment
- 6 = Outpatient Drug or Alcohol Clinic
- 7 = Mental Health or Community Health Center
- 8 = Psychiatrist, Psychologist, Social Worker, or Psychiatric Nurse
- 9 = In-home Counseling or In-home Crisis Services
- 10 = Family Doctor or any other Medical Doctor
- 11 = Hospital Emergency Room
- 12 = School Guidance Counselor, School Psychologist, or School Social Worker
- 13 = Special classroom in a regular school
- 14 = Special Help or Tutoring in the regular classroom
- 15 = Special school for students
- 16 = Outpatient help or treatment from an in-person or online self-help or support group

CARD 9

- 1 = Person in family with health insurance lost job or changed employers
- 2 = Got divorced or separated/death of spouse or parent
- 3 = Became ineligible because of age/left school
- 4 = Employer does not offer coverage/or not eligible for coverage
- 5 = Cost is too high
- 6 = Insurance company refused coverage
- 7 = Medicaid/Medical plan stopped after pregnancy
- 8 = Lost Medicaid/Medical plan because of a new job or increase in income
- 9 = Lost Medicaid (other)
- 10 = Other

CD1 1 = I am sad once in a while
 2 = I am sad many times
 3 = I am sad all the time

CD2 1 = Nothing will ever work out for me
 2 = I am not sure if things will work out for me
 3 = Things will work out for me O.K.

CD3 1 = I do most things O.K.
 2 = I do many things wrong
 3 = I do everything wrong

CARD 11

CD7 1 = I hate myself
 2 = I do not like myself
 3 = I like myself

CD10 1 = I feel like crying everyday
 2 = I feel like crying many days
 3 = I feel like crying once in a while

CD11 1 = Things bother me all the time
 2 = Things bother me many times
 3 = Things bother me once in a while

CARD 12

CD14 1 = I look O.K.
 2 = There are some bad things about my looks
 3 = I look ugly

CD20 1 = I do not feel alone
 2 = I feel alone many times
 3 = I feel alone all the time

CD22 1= I have plenty of friends
 2 = I have some friends but I wish I had more
 3 = I do not have any friends

CD25 1 = Nobody really loves me
 2 = I am not sure if anybody loves me
 3 = I am sure that somebody loves me

CARD 13

1 = Never

2 = Sometimes

3 = Lots of Times

4 = Almost All of the Time

CARD 14

1 = Not True

2 = Somewhat or Sometimes True

3 = Very True or Often True

CARD 15

- 1 = Foster care or kinship services
- 2 = Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
- 3 = Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP)
- 4 = Special Education Services
- 5 = In-home counseling or in-home crisis services
- 6 = Family counseling
- 7 = Therapeutic nursery care
- 8 = Mental health services or treatment
- 9 = Job-related services
- 10 = Organized support groups: Alcoholics Anonymous, Parents Anonymous, etc.
- 11 = Child care services
- 12 = Services for alcohol or drug problems
- 13 = Parenting skills training
- 14 = Training on ways to discipline child
- 15 = Home management training (e.g., budgeting or planning meals)
- 16 = Respite care for a child
- 17 = Transportation help
- 18 = Case manager visits or other types of contacts with case manager
